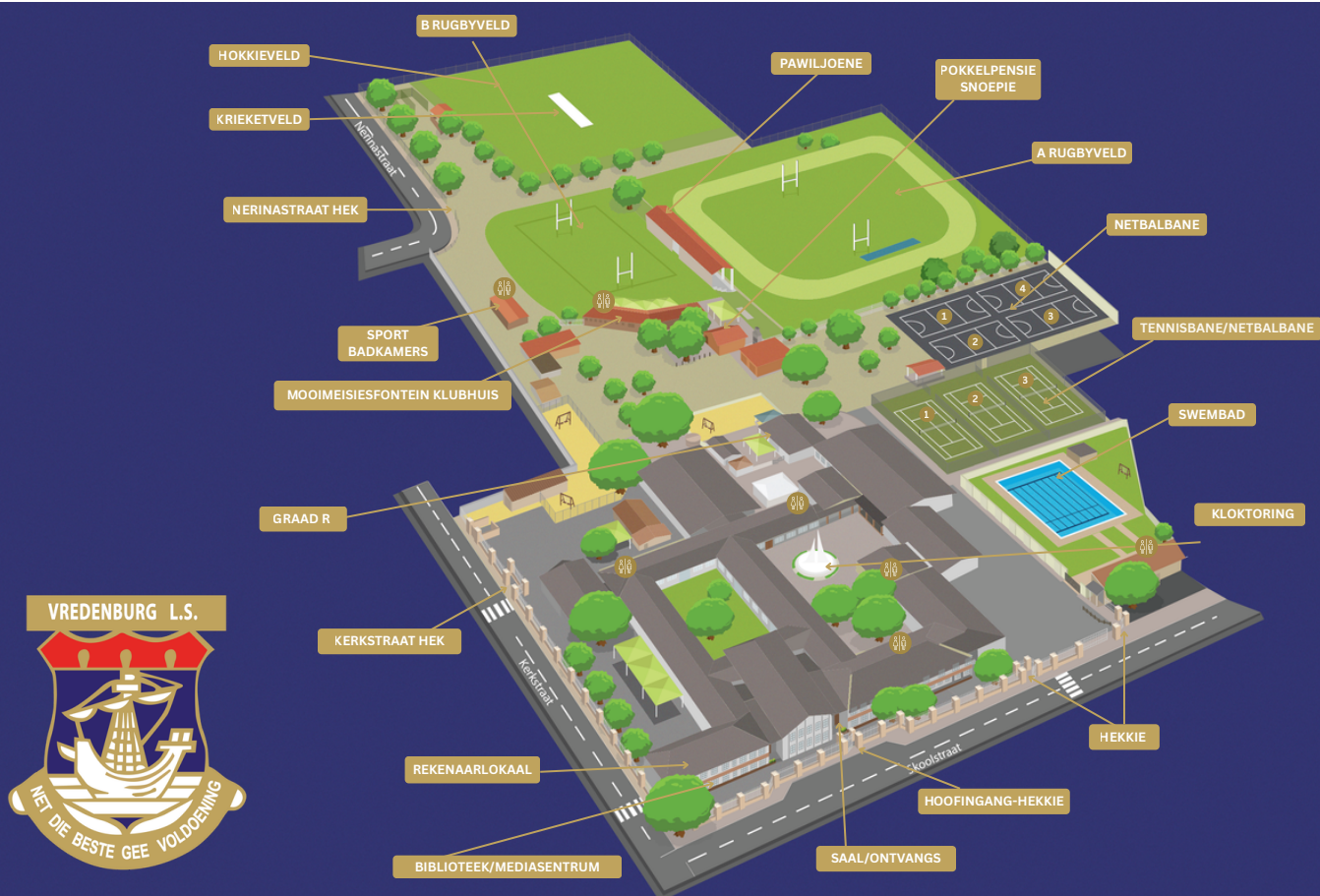

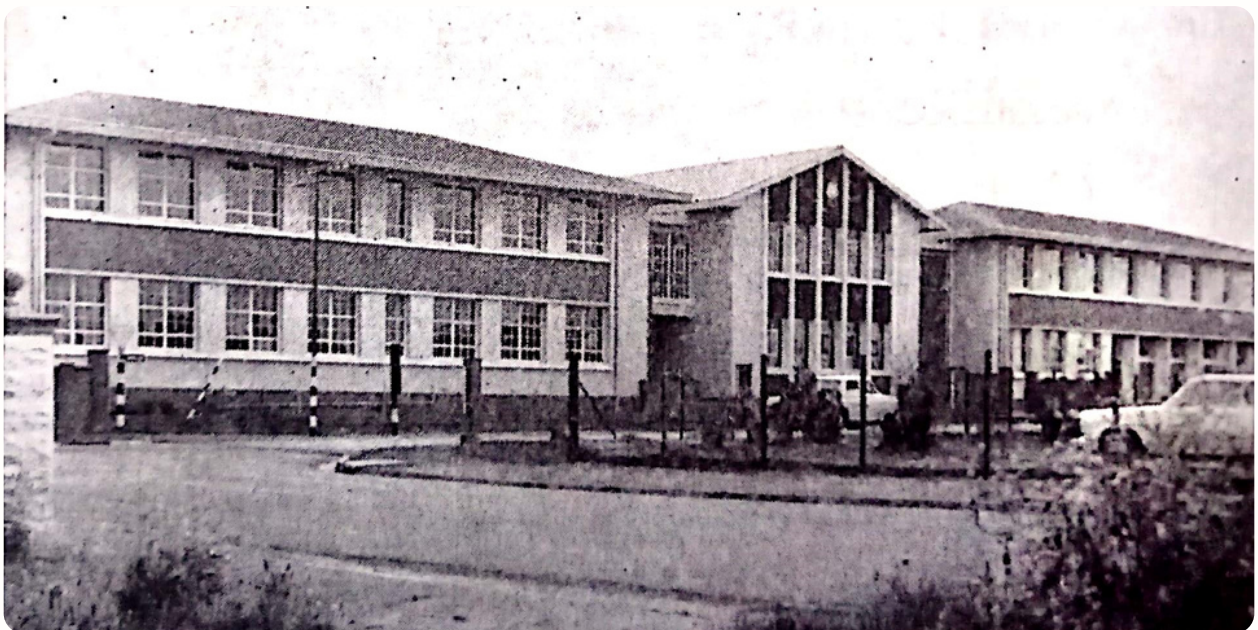
Welcome

Our History

The first school in our town was originally a small farm school established in 1880. It had one principal and one teacher, and learners did not wear a school uniform.

In 1923, the first high school was established in Vredenburg, with Mr J. P. A. Lochner serving as its first principal. The school provided education for learners from Grade 1 to Grade 12. There was no school hall at the time, and learners gathered where the garden is situated today.

Today, a marble memorial plaque on the wall of the Media Centre commemorates Mr Lochner's dedicated service to the children and the community.



In 1972, Grades 8 to 12 moved to a new building next door. Vredenburg Primary School and Vredenburg High School then became two separate schools, each with its own principal.

Mr W. C. Verster was appointed as the first principal of Vredenburg Primary School. The Willa Verster School Hall was later named in his honour in recognition of his outstanding leadership, dedication, and service as a principal and educator.

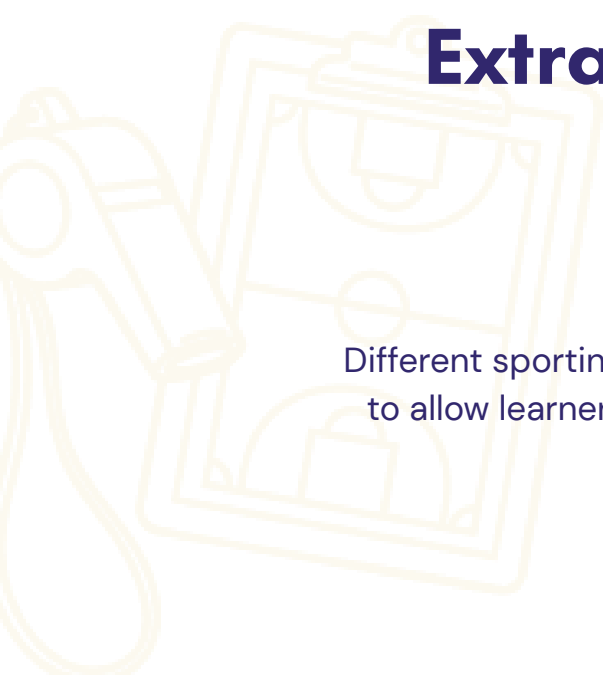

Symbolism

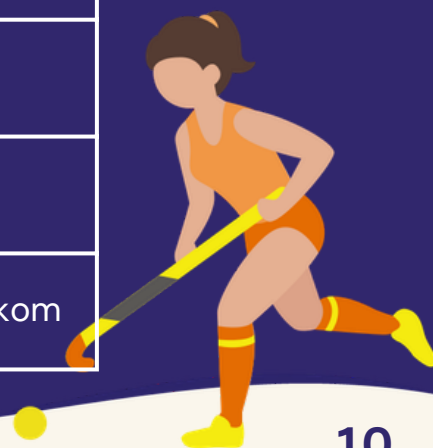
The three golden sheaves of wheat symbolise the attainment of full maturity through growth. Growth can only lead to true maturity when it is balanced, consistent, and disciplined.

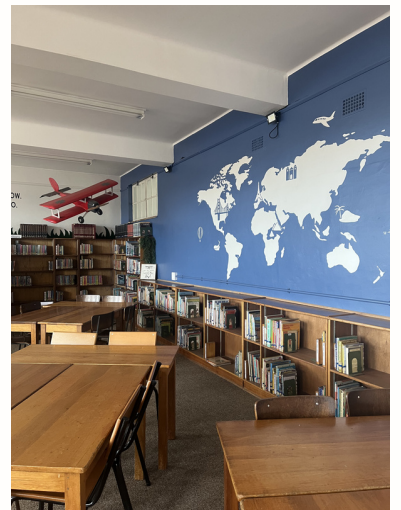

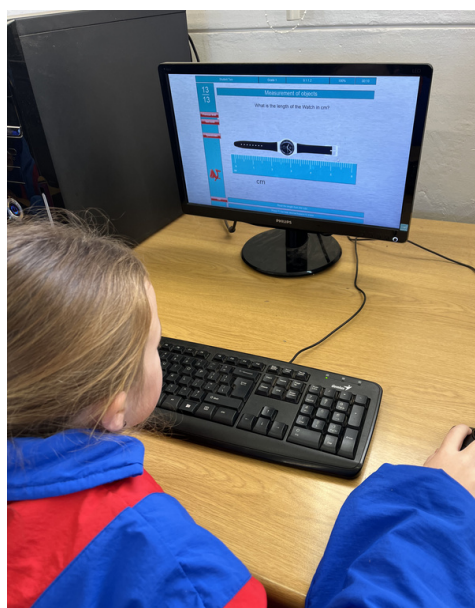
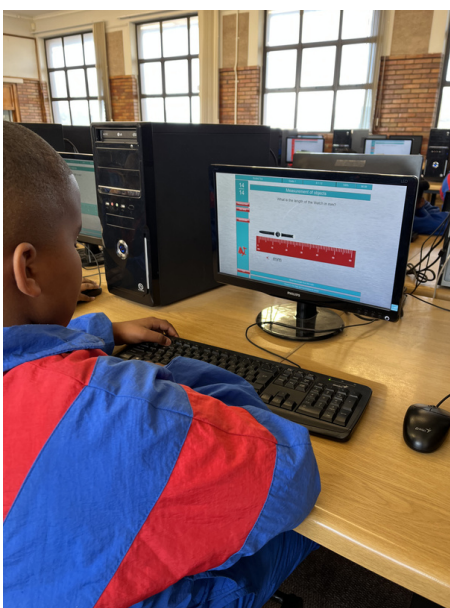
At Vredenburg Primary School, learners enjoy swimming as part of our Life Skills (LS) curriculum and summer sports programme.
